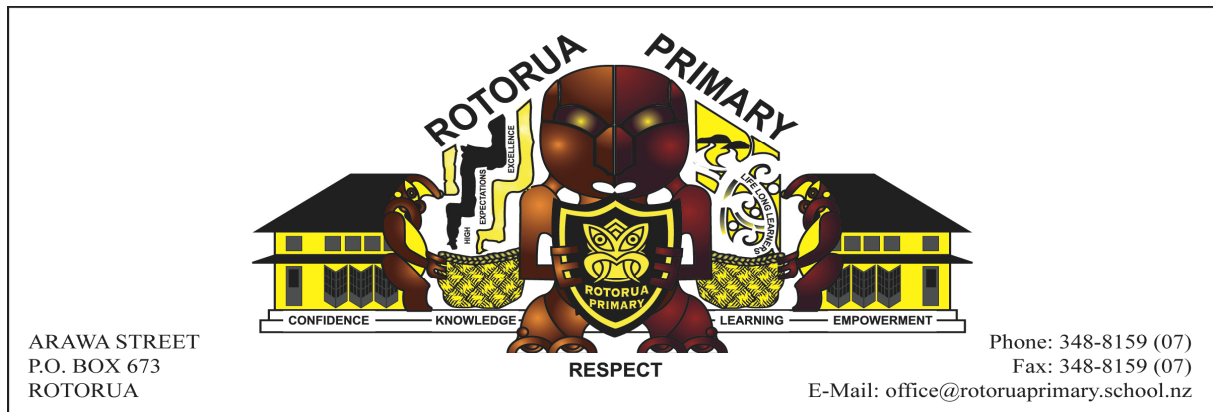


# NEWSLETTER



**This newsletter is to remind PARENTS / CAREGIVERS of the importance of next Tuesdays (15 June) Community Hui.**

The topics covered will be:

1. The new reports for half year, how to read them and what they mean for parents/caregivers. These reports are a template set by the Government for schools.
2. Where should our students be at the end of each Year? (National Standards)
3. How can you as parents/caregivers help your child to achieve each year? This is a component in the reports that the Government have put in that parents need to be aware of.
